The tag holder transferring the big game tag must accompany the minor receiving the mule deer tag into the field, regardless of the age of the minor, and have on their person a copy of the Department signed tag transfer affidavit.), #9 (A tag holder may only transfer a tag through this program once in their lifetime) and #13A (“Accompany into the field” means the youth and adult must remain close enough for the adult to see and provide verbal assistance to the youth hunter, no more than 10 yards. Using electronic devices, such as walkie talkies or cell phones, does not meet this requirement); Along with adjusting the deadline on stipulation #5 to “no later than 14 calendar days prior to the hunt start date.” Instead of July 1st,~~
